

Connecting IOS devices to the wireless

Step #1

To connect an iPad or iPhone to the ODU wireless network you will need to navigate to Settings. (Check to make sure Airplane Mode is set to off.) In the Settings select Wi-Fi, also check that WI-FI is set to on. Under Choose a Network ODU-WIRELESS should show up, select it. (it may take a minute for the network to show up.)



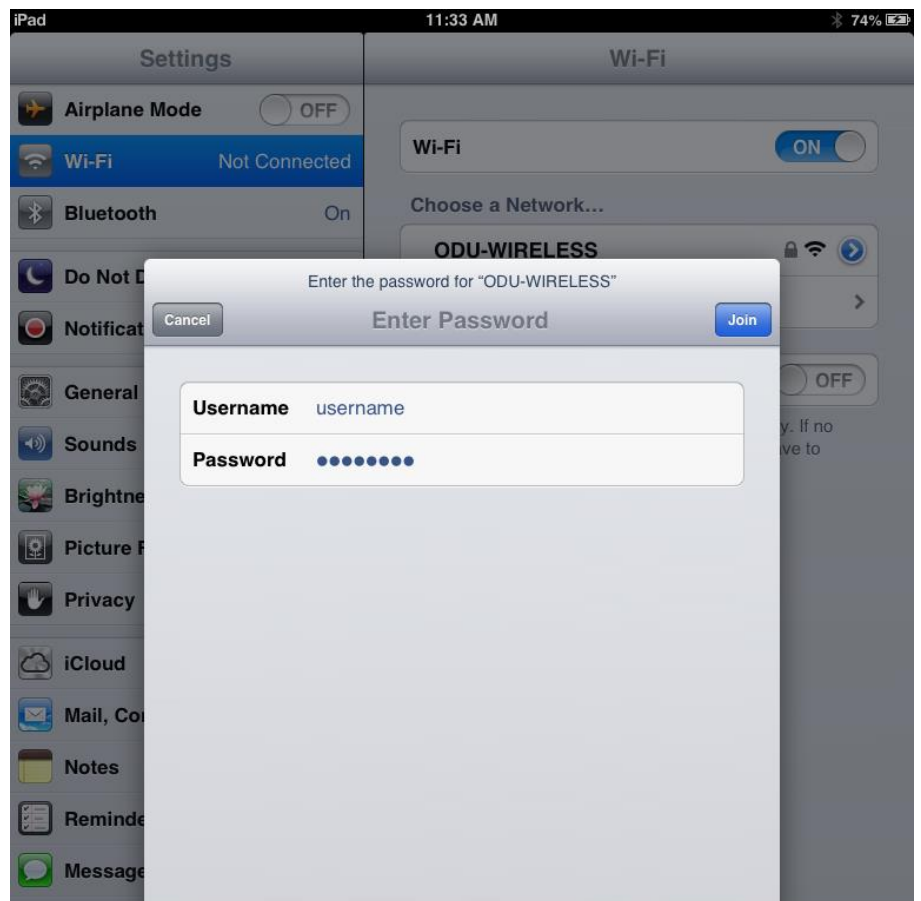
Note: If you changed your password or had to get a password reset by the ODU Computer Helpdesk you will need to forget the ODU-WIRELESS connection first. In order to forget the network you will need to tap the blue circle with a with arrow (which is circled in black below), then tap Forget this Network.



Step #2

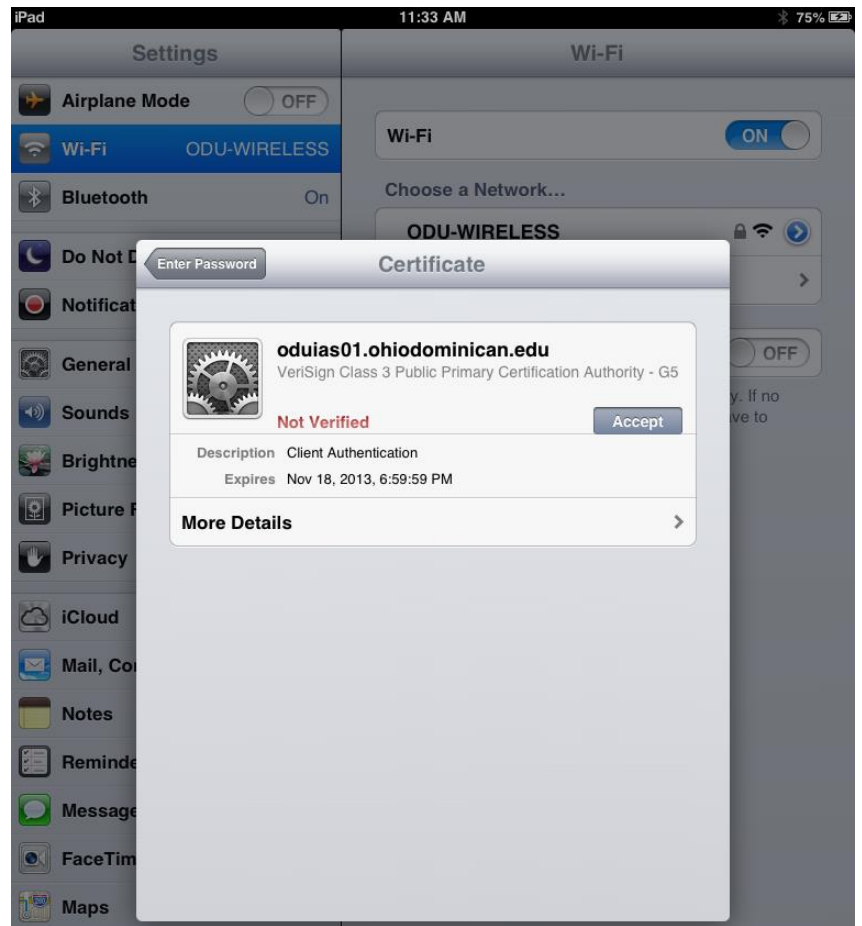
When prompted enter your ODU username and ODU password

Note If you only have a password field you will need to go back and forget the network because there is still a remembered password in your device from when it was last connected.



Step #3

A Certificate pop up box will appear on the screen, you will need to tap accept.



Step #4

Go to your web browser and navigate to any web page, the browser will redirect to the Bradford registration page. Enter your ODU user name and Password, and then click on download.

Note: No software is downloaded to the iPhone or iPad.

As long as the ODU username and password entered is correct the Successful registration page should appear. Turn the device off and restart the device. Open your web browser and confirm internet connection by browsing to a new webpage.
