

How do I register my game console?

1. All game console registrations must be submitted online at: <http://helpdesk.ohiodominican.edu>
2. Click on "Submit an Online Request Form!"
3. Log in
4. Go to Helpdesk Support Form
5. Fill out the problem Description:
 - a. Please register my...
 - b. Game Console Type
 - c. MAC or Physical Address
6. Click Submit
7. Your game console must remain connected and turned on until you receive confirmation that it is registered.

How do I find my game console MAC Address?

To find the MAC address of your Xbox 360?

1. Go to the "System" area of the Xbox Dashboard;
2. Select "Network Settings"
3. Select "Edit Settings."
4. Select "Additional Settings"
5. Select "Advanced Settings"
6. At the bottom of this screen you'll see a heading called "Wired MAC Address," which is your MAC address.

To find the MAC address of your Xbox?

Turn on your Xbox console with no game disc in the disc tray.
From the Xbox Dashboard, choose "Settings."
From the "Settings" screen, select "Network Settings."
The MAC address is the 12-digit number at the bottom-right corner of the "Network Settings" screen.

To find the MAC address for your Nintendo Wii?

1. From the Wii Channel menu, select "Wii Settings" (the round button on the bottom-left of the screen with "Wii" on it).
2. Select "Internet," then "Console Settings."
3. The MAC address of the Wii console is displayed on the first line.

To find the MAC address of your GameCube?

1. Unplug the GameCube and flip it over
2. Remove the broadband adapter from the bottom of the GameCube;
3. Flip the adapter over
4. The adapter address is printed on the underside of adapter.

To find the MAC address of your Sony PlayStation 3?

1. Navigate to the Settings icon (located on the far left).
2. Press the "X" button.
3. Navigate up/down until you see the System Settings icon.
4. Press the "X" button.
5. Scroll up/down until you see System Information.
6. Press the "X" button.

The MAC address will be displayed as well as the system software version, current IP address, and remaining hard disk capacity.

To find the MAC address of your PlayStation 2?

To find the MAC address of your Sony PlayStation 2 you will need the Network Adaptor connected to the PS2 and you will need the disc that came with the Network Adaptor. Then follow these steps:

1. Power up the PlayStation 2 and load the Network Adaptor Startup Disc.
2. Once it has loaded, select "ISP Setup" and press X on your controller.
3. The ISP Setup will begin to load, and you will be presented with a license agreement. Select Agree and press X to continue.
4. For connection type, choose "Local Area Network (LAN)" and press X to continue.
5. Select "Automatic Configuration" and press X to continue.
6. At the connection test screen, select "Advanced" and press X to continue.
7. At the "Advanced Broadband Settings" screen, make sure "Automatic" is selected. While you are at this screen, make note of the MAC address at the bottom.
