

Mobility Print Instructions for an Android Device

Step 1: Make sure your Android is connected to PantherNet.

Step 2: Install the Mobility Print app from the Google Play Store.

Step 3: Launch the app.

Step 4: Tap on Android settings.

Step 5: Tap on Mobility Print.

Step 6: Tap the Enable toggle. If it is already on, do not tap the Enable toggle.

Step 7: Exit out of Settings.

Step 8: Print your document. When prompted, enter your ODU username and password.

The way you print is different depending on the app you want to print from. For more information, see the documentation for the app. When you select a printer, make sure you select Panther_Printing_Mobile as identified by the Mobility Print app icon.

If you select the "Remember me" check box, your phone will remember your ODU login credentials for that printer for 30 days.

Note:

- If you need to assign an account to your print job, then you can do so at the MFD or via the Mobile web client.

Device Requirements:

Android 4.4+

Android phones and tablets from Google, Samsung, HTC, Lenovo, LG, Sony, Huawei among others.
